Gateway To Work

-  GTW is a community engagement program that seeks to improve HIP members' physical and mental health, overall financial stability and well-being.
-  Connect HIP Members with job training, education and volunteer activities
-  Requirements: Work, School, Volunteer, etc.
 - Up to 80 hours for at least 8 months

Gateway to Work Status

 HIP members will be assigned a GTW referral status based on the information on file with the State.

- **Exempt** – Members who meet any of the defined exemptions will not be required to participate in the program.
- **Reporting Met** – Members who have reported at least 80 hours per month of employment to DFR.
- **Reporting** – HIP Members are required to complete GTW requirements to keep your HIP benefits.

Qualifying Activities

Employment

- Health plan (MCE) employment initiatives
- Job search activities
- Education related to employment (on-the-job training)

Education

- General Education (High School Equivalency), Adult education, post-secondary, general education
- Job skills training
- Vocation education or training
- English as a second language education

Qualifying Activities, cont

Community Engagement

- Community service/public service
- Volunteer work
- Community work experience


Other

- Caregiving services
- Homeschooling
- Public service


Required Hours

Date	Required participation hours
January 2019 – June 2019	0 hours per week/0 hours per month
July 2019 – September 2019	5 hours per week/20 hours per month
October 2019 – December 2019	10 hours per week/40 hours per month
January 2020 – June 2020	15 hours per week/60 hours per month
July 2020 – Ongoing	20 hours per week/80 hours per month


Reporting Activity Hours



Exemptions

 Some HIP members are exempt from having to participate from Gateway to Work based on health, education and other factors.



Exemptions Included are:

- Student
- Pregnant
- Certified Illness or Incapacity (temporary)
- Medically Frail
- Age 60 or over
- Caregiver of a dependent child younger than 7 years old
- Primary caregiver of a disabled dependent
- Substance Use Disorder (SUD)
- Homeless
- TANF/SNAP recipients
- Recently incarcerated (more than 30 days)
- Kinship caregiver of abused or neglected children (CHINS caregiver)
- Good Cause


Good Cause Exemption

-  Please contact MHS 877-647-4848 and select the option for Gateway to Work if you think you might have a Good Cause exemption.
-  MHS GTW team will submit Good Cause requests and to the state GTW team for review and decision.
