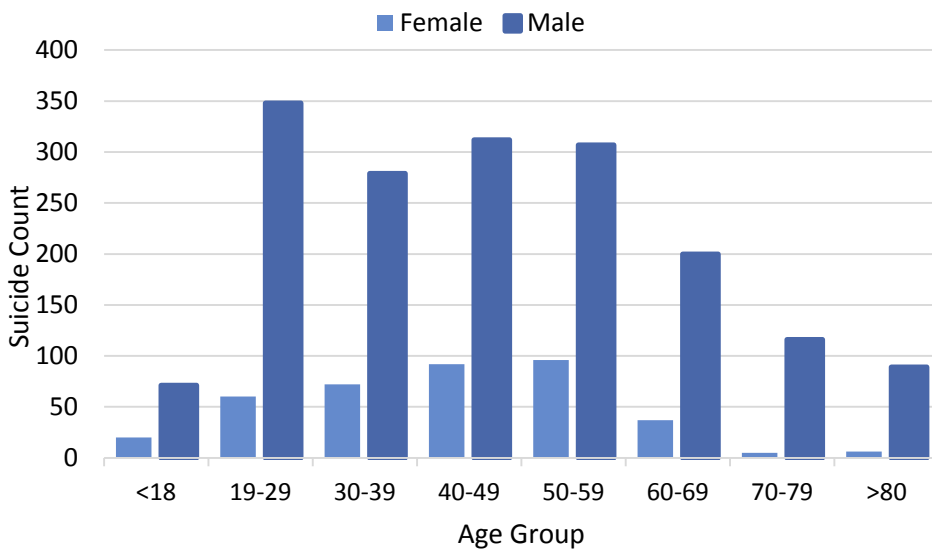

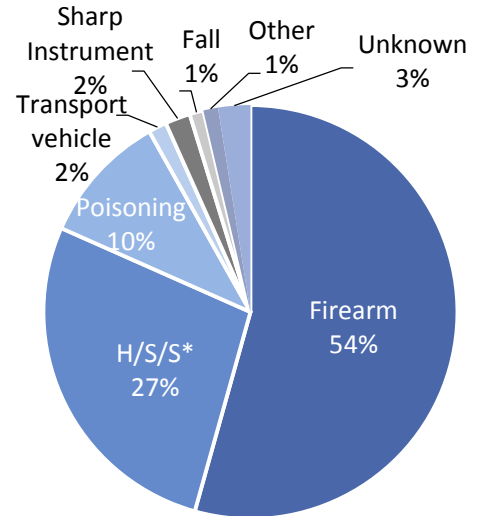

Suicide by Age and Sex

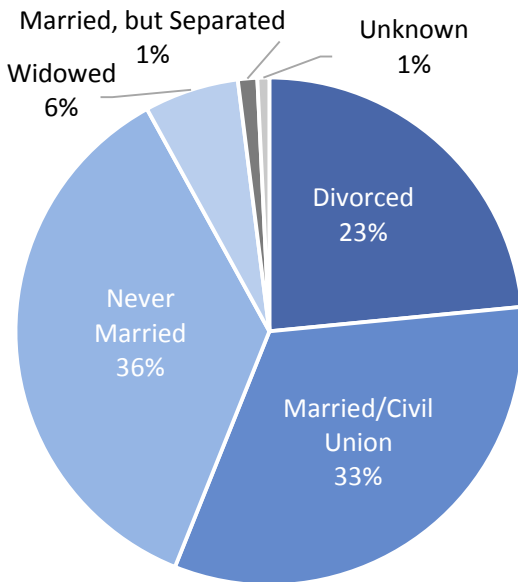


Suicide Cause of Death

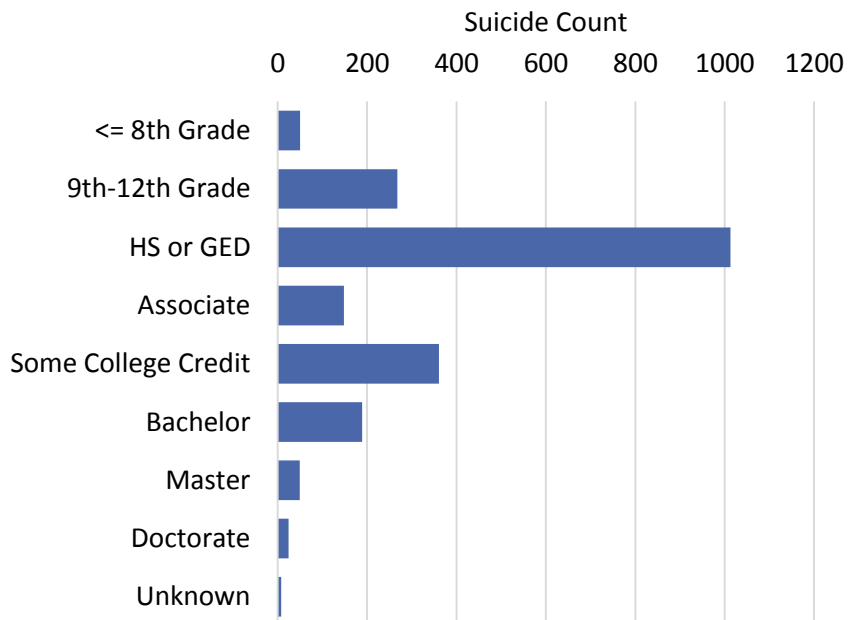

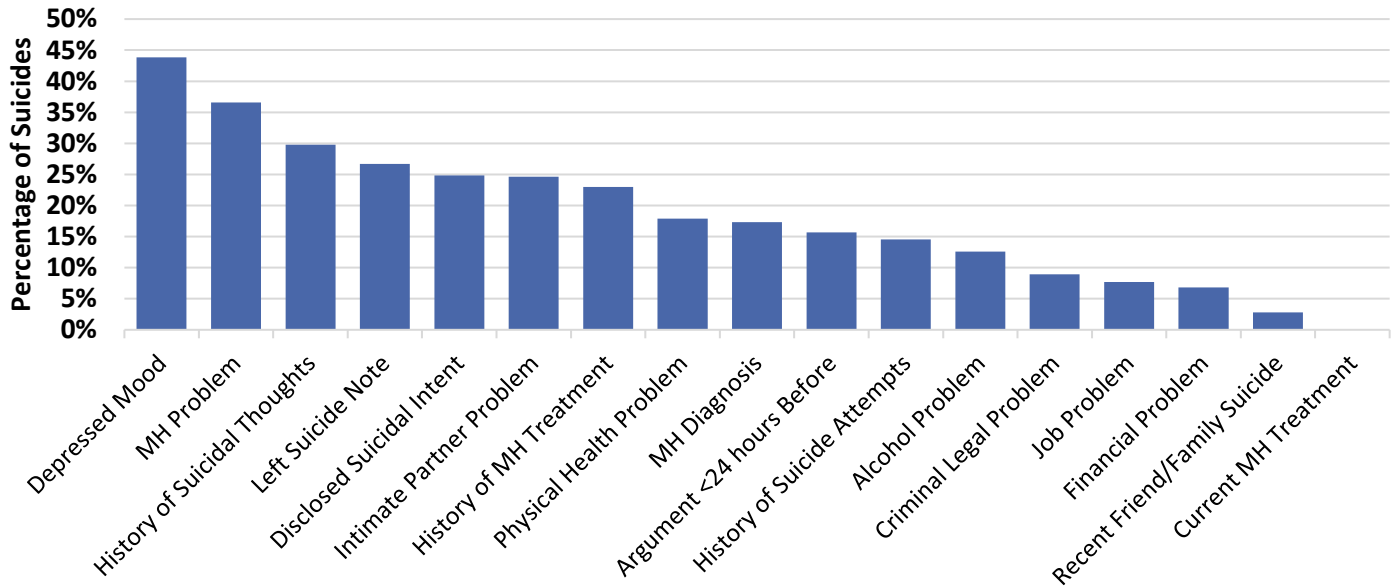


Education Level of Suicide Decedents

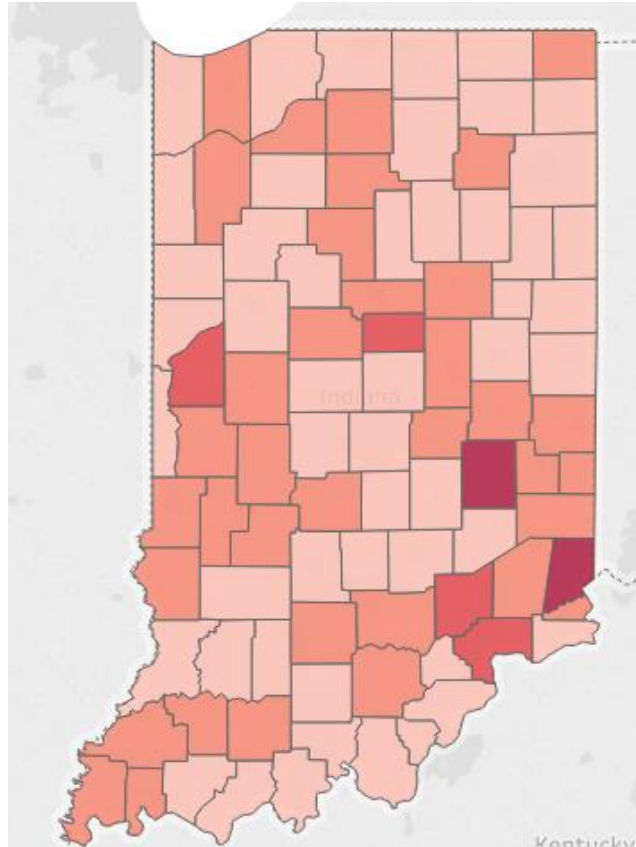
Suicide Circumstances



MH= Mental Health. The number above the bar represents the number of suicides where the circumstance was present.

Of those with Mental Health Diagnoses, 254 were diagnosed with depression, 24 with bipolar disorder, 5 with ADD or hyperactive disorder, 12 with an anxiety disorder, 7 with PTSD, and 26 with schizophrenia. A decedent could be diagnosed with multiple disorders.

Prevalence of Suicides Occuring in Indiana, 2016-2017



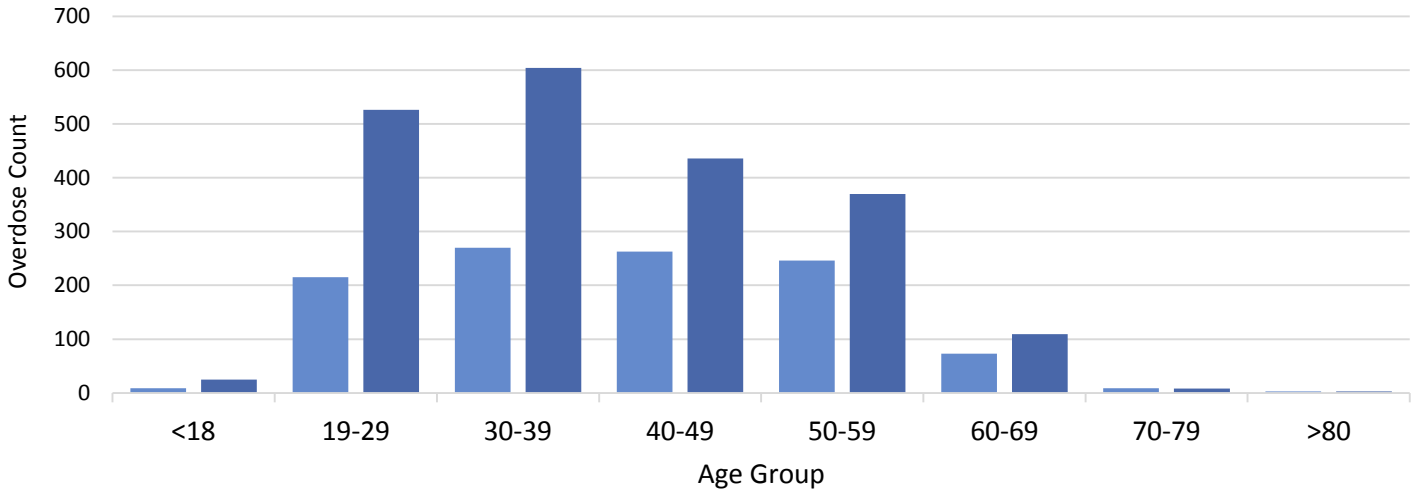

A total of **3164** unintentional drug overdose deaths occurred in Indiana in 2016-2017. The data below is based off those deaths.

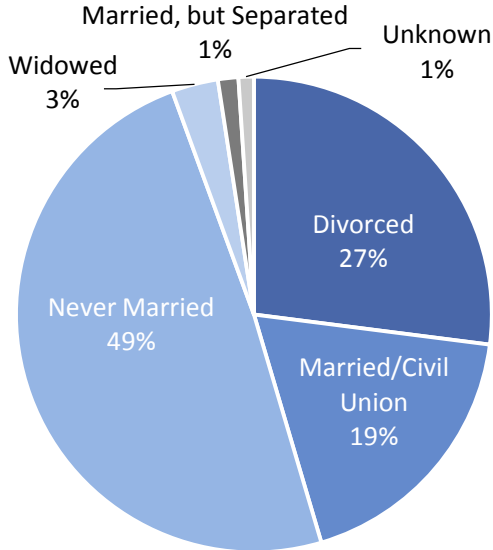
Overdoses by Age and Sex

■ Female ■ Male

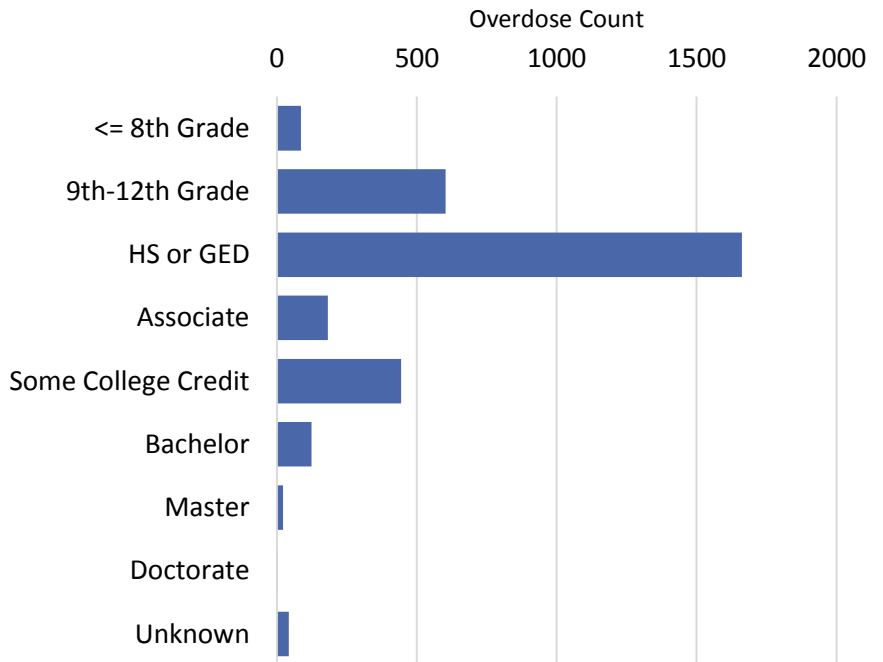


Marital Status

(Status, count, percentage of Overdoses)

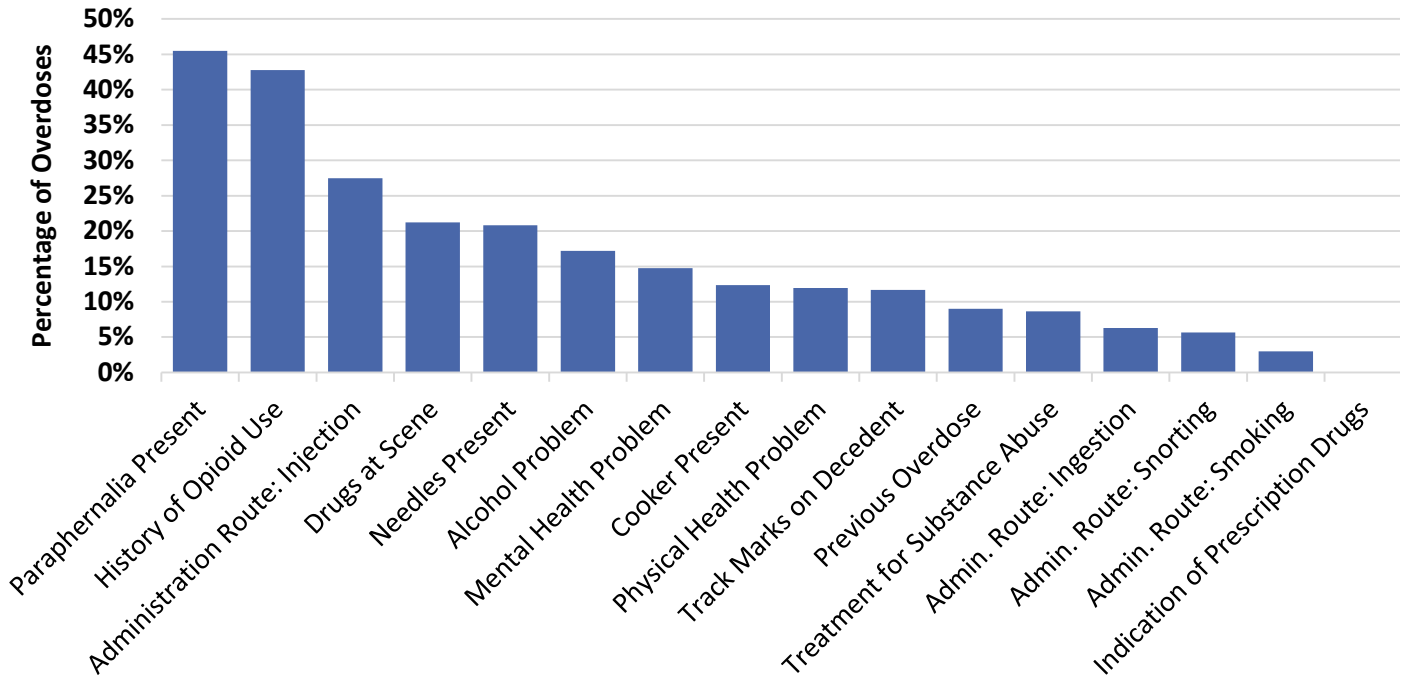


Education Level of Overdose Decedents

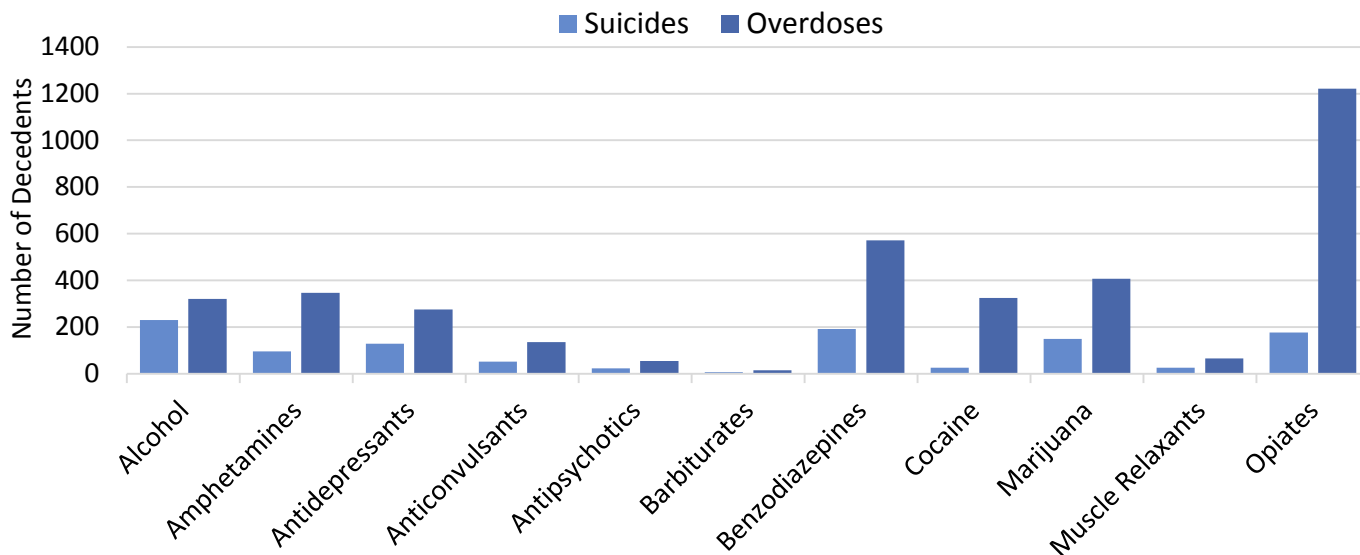

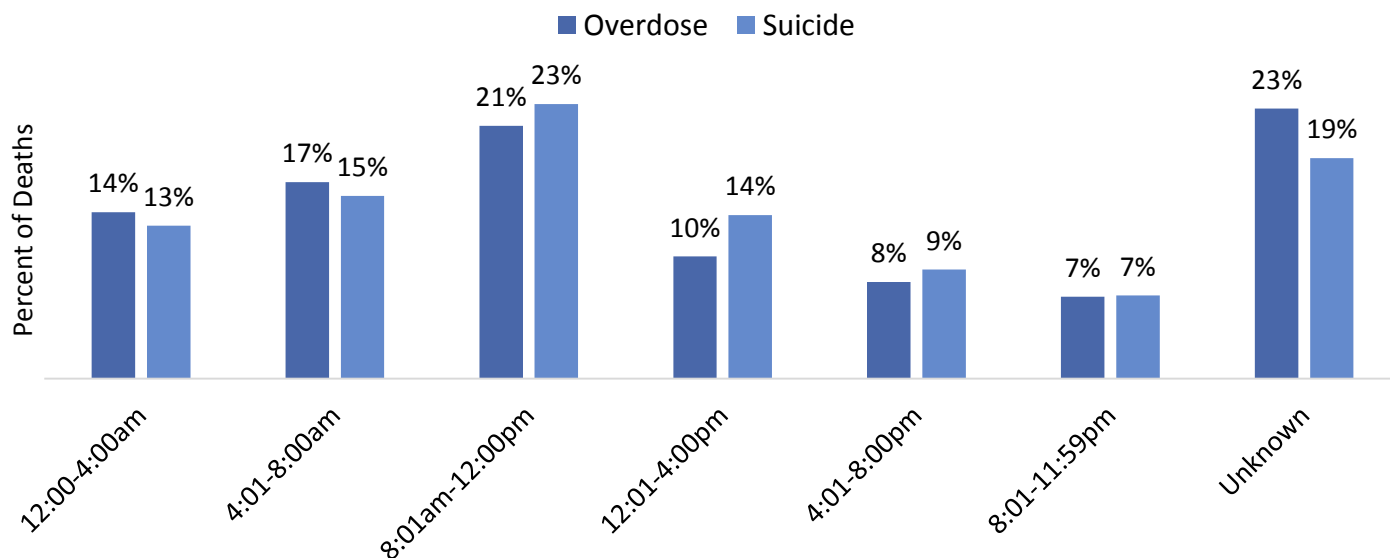
Substances Present in Suicide and Unintentional Drug Overdose Decedents
